





In 2012, Give2GiveHope will be celebrating its third year since becoming an official 501(c)(3) non-profit. We are still a relatively young organization. We are learning how to do things better; how to serve the communities we work in more effectively; how to partner with our volunteers, donors and other organizations; and what new programs or services we should invest in and explore.

In 2011, we had a tremendously successful fundraising campaign with the Handley School K-5 students, held our first event - the "Hoopla for Hope", led our second team to Honduras on a mission trip, had great success with "Project Clean H2Ope" water filters, and bought our first piece of equipment for our future vocational center in Honduras. More children were sponsored in 2011 as we continue our mission to provide hope for a better tomorrow to impoverished children by partnering with local churches to meet physical and spiritual needs.

It was because of kind and compassionate donors that we were able to do all these things. We depend on that ongoing support to be able to continue to provide services and expand our reach to help even more children. Give2GiveHope has several project funds that allow our donors to give to us in ways that help children while meeting their charitable giving goals: monthly child sponsorship, the Last Supper fund, educational /vocational support, water filtration systems, medical care and assistance, Vision Catcher mission scholarships and our 'unsponsored children' fund which helps urgent needs children, who do not receive regular assistance.

As we look to 2012 and beyond, we are thankful for those who have joined us on this journey, who have been helpful in getting us to this point, and found a way - in spite of the uncertain economic times - to show they care by giving what they have to give hope to others who are in such great need. Every gift makes a difference - big or small - and so I say 'Thank You' once again for your support. We can not do God's work, God's way, in God's time and for God's glory without you!

Our June 2011 trip to Honduras had two primary purposes: to install water filters (see info on Project Clean H2Ope), and to perform our annual enrollment and re-registration process for the children in our program. In 2010, we saw our enrollment increase from 113 children to 295, almost tripling the number of children in the program in 2009. We were caught by surprise once again in 2011 when our numbers doubled again to almost **600 children!** Fortunately, we came prepared with just the right number of flip-flops, toothbrushes, toothpaste and toys for the children. The center of our ministry remains the physical and spiritual growth of impoverished children in the areas we serve by supplying food, clothing, medical care and education in partnership with the local church. In 2011, our program grew from 42 to 71 children sponsored... a 70% increase. Our goal is to have 90 children sponsored by the end of 2012.

We were presented with a new situation this year that was shocking and heartbreaking at the same time. During our registration day in June, several children were registered whose parents had abandoned them. They were being cared for by neighbors or others who took pity on them. We have made it a priority to find sponsors for these abandoned children and other urgent needs children with special focus on those who have been waiting for a sponsor for over 2 years. Time isn't wasted searching and gathering wood to boil water or to fetch 'clean' water from remote locations.

In 2011, Give2GiveHope was able to install 64 water filters which was a huge success for our first year! Thank you to our donors who sponsored a water filter in 2011. By the end of 2012, our goal is to have over 100 filters installed in Honduras.
